Wyoming All-State

1950, April 25-29 ... the first mass band to be held in conjunction with state solo and ensemble festival in Casper

1952, May 1-3 ... mass band in conjunction with state solo and ensemble festival in Casper.

1954, April 30, May 1-2 ... mass band in conjunction with state solo and ensemble festival in Casper.

1955, May 5-6 ... UW hosted a state honor band.

1956, May 4-5 ... mass band in conjunction with state solo and ensemble festival in Casper.

1958, May 2-3 ... mass band, orchestra and chorus, in conjunction with state solo and ensemble festival in Casper.

1959, May 1-2 ... UW hosted a state honor band, chorus and orchestra.

1960, May 6-7 ... mass band, orchestra and chorus, in conjunction with state solo and ensemble festival in Casper.

1962, May 2-3 ... mass band, orchestra and chorus, in conjunction with state solo and ensemble festival in Casper.

1964, May 1-2 ... mass band, orchestra and chorus, in conjunction with state solo and ensemble festival in Casper.

1965, May 7-8 ... mass band, choir and orchestra in Cheyenne and the start of All-State as we know it today. State solos and ensembles were eliminated as part of the state festival. This was also the beginning of a rotation through different communities in Wyoming to host the state honor groups. Auditions replaced recommendations and/or festival ratings for participation in the state event.
